

NAME DECEPTION

The process of how your name is created, adapted and then used throughout your life is very similar in all countries; however the following describes how this deception is carried out within the UK Corporation.

To show the process, we shall use the name ***“John Henry Doe”*** written here in title case English, meaning the first letter of each word or name is uppercase, and the rest is spelt using lowercase.

DOE

The first name given to you is your last name, or surname, written here in all caps as ***“DOE”***. This was written on the Birth Notification form BNF01 along with a date; meaning on the date of your birth you were given your surname or ***“slave-name”***.

Although this name may sound like your family name, that too was also taken from your grandparents, and is also a corporate name not belonging to them.

Your family name was changed into a surname long ago.

John Henry

There will be a second date on the birth notification form, this is the date of registration and involves your forenames, written here in title case English as ***“John Henry”***.

This is where your mother was tricked into giving over your forenames, on form 1 ***“Particulars of Birth”***.

This is why your forenames and surname are written separately on the form.

Note: Your Mother has become the ***“informer”***, meaning she has ***“informed”*** the hospital to notify the government that she has abandoned her child after birth.

John Henry DOE

The birth registrar took both names and the second date from the registration date, and created the registered name ***“John Henry DOE”***.

This name now becomes a ***“certified copy of an entry”*** with a document being created. This is sometimes confused as being the birth certificate, but it is not.

It is just to certify an entry has been registered, and the document may highlight an ***“application number”***, or ***“docket number”***, with the form being smaller than a birth certificate.

Note: These forms will be boxed and display symbolism and acronyms not easily recognised or understood.

Once the application has been made, your ***“legal name”*** has now been created, which is attached to a contract within commerce; hence the creation of your ***“corporate name”***, often referred to as an ***“implied company name”*** or unofficially ***“strawman”***, has been completed.

Note: Only living breathing men or women can trade; corporations carry out commerce. These two jurisdictions cannot mix, meaning no man or woman can ever be in contract with a corporation, so an ***“implied company name”*** has to be created in your name.

This ***“legal name”*** strips you of your sovereign status and lowers you to a level that can be controlled, and because you know nothing of this and have not claimed this ***“legal name”***, you are considered a ***“child”*** or a ***“minor”*** without responsibility, and are therefore unable to be heard.

The United Kingdom Corporation limited has become your ***“legal parents”***.

Once your legal name has been created, it is then applied to all corporations including governmental, and every document now has your ***“implied company name”*** attached to it, such as:

- Driver’s licence.
- Passport.
- Bank account.
- Car log book or registration.
- Business registration.
- Deeds to your house.

Mr John Henry DOE

Applying the title ***Mr***, or ***Mrs*** for a woman, lowers the status of your ***“implied company”*** to beneath all other titles within the ***legal system***, and enters you into ***“Mercantile law”***.

Note: The title Miss means the woman has ***“missed”*** her title, and has no value or estate, although this has now been changed in modern times, with the introduction of women now becoming a human commodity within the work force.

This title not only lowers your status, but shows other corporations that you are unaware of the deception, as you have accepted the title ***“Mr”***.

The title ***“Mr”*** can be applied from the age of 13, this is to ensure that your right to hold an estate has been removed before you ***come of age*** or reach the ***age of consent***.

Your estate shall now be ***“placed into trust”***, with the title ***“Mr”*** referring to your ***“foreign situs trust”***, which allows the ***court*** to gain access to said trust if the title ***“Mr”*** is applied to you.

Furthermore your last name will be written in all uppercase, which does not follow the grammatical rules of English to display your name, as it has now become an acronym.

Note: Almost all traffic tickets sent via the postal service will be addressed in this way.

However, do not be fooled, as this is not your name, but two single names and an acronym that resembles your true name.

Mr John Henry Doe

It is possible to receive documentation where your name is written in full using title case English; however the title ***“Mr”*** has still been applied.

Again, this lowers your status as before, but the deception is not so easy to spot. When receiving documents addressed in this manner, you should question the sender as to the meaning of the title and name given.

MR JOHN HENRY DOE

The all caps name, written in this manner, comes from “*Mercantile law*”, when a passenger comes on board ship to engage in safe passage at sea.

The captain of the ship would make up the manifest of the cargo he has taken on board, and holds responsibility and liability of said cargo.

The cargo would be valued before setting sail. This set value would be the cost of liability if anything were to happen to it, leaving the captain with the agreed upon financial liability.

However, the price of life attributed to a man or woman could not be expressed and therefore liability could not be agreed upon before setting sail.

So the captain would agree to cover the cost of medical needs or funeral costs to the living, if something should go wrong.

Note: the title ***Captain*** refers to the one responsible for all the “*capital*”.

Therefore the name of the passenger would be written as a “*sign*”, in all caps, so as not to use the correctly written name of the passenger.

Today if you receive mail addressed this way, it is either written as “*American Sign Language*” or, if you are following the grammatical rules of English, it is an acronym.

Either way you should question the sender.

Mr John-Henry DOE

You may see your name written with the use of a hyphen.

The use of a hyphen is to connect two words together to form a new meaning, and is used to create a double-barrelled surname.

So if your name is written as above, you have the title “*Mr*” with a double-barrelled surname and an acronym.

MR JOHN-HENRY DOE

According to The Chicago Manual of Style, anything written in all capital letters with an added hyphen is sign language. It is also an acronym.

Reference the Chicago manual of style 16th edition Section 11.149.

JOHN HENRY DOE

With the whole name written in all caps, and using the grammatical rules of English, this name has become an acronym.

This style of writing your name is utilised when an ***implied company*** is used, which is a ***fictitious name***, used within the ***legal system***.

Note: This style of writing your name came from when ship captains would write down your name on the ship's manifest, and accepted the financial liability for it, but **not** the liability of your life.

These implied companies are either made-up, or belong to the ***UK Corporation***.

JOHN HENRY DOE LTD

LTD is an abbreviation for the word ***limited***, and is used when a company becomes its own ***legal property***.

Meaning that it is only the ***"company"*** that may owe money to a creditor, however **not** the owner of said company. It limits liability to that of the legal fiction.

With your name written in this way, it has become a ***private limited company***, expressed to the world, as a ***legal title***.

For another company to interact with you, they must have a contract with your limited company.

JOHN-HENRY DOE

With the first two names now joined with a hyphen, it becomes ***"sign language"***, with the last name becoming an ***acronym***.

John Henry Doe

Although written in title case English, this is still presenting three separate names.

John-Henry Doe

Adding a hyphen in-between the first two names now joins them together creating a new word, or name.

This could be taken as a double-barrelled surname, followed by another surname, as all names start with a capital letter.

J H Doe

Although initials can be used within a Christian name, what the initials stand for should be questioned, and verified.

Note: an ***initial*** should be followed with a full stop.

John henry Doe

With the ***first*** and ***last*** name written in title case English, and the middle name written in all lower case, this is still considered the ***"legal name"***.

Even under ***Christian common law***, a ***legal name*** consists of one ***Christian name*** and one ***surname***, with the addition, or omission of a middle name being immaterial.

Note: a **Christian name** is not a **“forename”**.

The **Christian name** was given to the system, using the **“certificate of name”** and if you use it you are using a **“dead entity sinful”** name.

Bank Accounts

You do not own your bank account, but have become an **“unpaid administrator”** of an account owned by a **corporation**.

For you to utilise this account, you will require the use of a legal fictitious name, this is created for you when you open any bank account.

If you open more than one account, new **“legal fictitious names”** will be created, using a combination of styles to write your name, previously mentioned.

Remedy

With the variety and amount of these many deceptions perpetrated by people hiding behind corporations, it would be prudent to take steps to protect your name.

This could be done by clearly stating the origin and meaning behind your name, and also printing your name using protective grammar, such as **“parse syntax grammar”** or **“quantum grammar”**.

Note: **Parse** means to determine a sentence into its component parts and describe their syntactic role.

When placing your mark onto a document, your name should be clearly written below your mark, written in English using the correct protective grammar.

For this example we shall use the name **John Henry Doe**.

Note: If your name is written incorrectly, the last name, in this case **“Doe”**, will be taken as your surname, which is a corporate legal fiction, controlled by the Vatican, that has the same **sound** as your family or house name.

Before writing your name you must first start with a colon **“:”** this means **“as follows”** or **“which is/are”** or **“thus”**, notifying the reader that what follows the colon is a statement of fact.

As you are writing your name, the first name should be written in **English Title Case**, highlighting this is your name or **“Title”**.

If you have a **middle name** then this should be written in all lower case following a hyphen from your first name. The hyphen joins the two, or more, names together.

If you do not wish to make reference to **“your surname”**, house name or family name, then close your name with a full stop. This is to stop anyone adding to your name, either in written fraud or by assumption.

If the family or house name is to be added, then a colon should close the first two names, and make reference to a new statement of fact, which in turn should be closed with a full stop.

See Example:

: John-henry: Doe.

Colon, Space, **John**, hyphen, **henry**, colon, space, **Doe**, full stop.

And as a final action of protection, the source and meaning of the name should be given.

Summary: When an agency or third party use a name upon you, the source of said name should always be questioned.
