



Neutral Response

Once the mail you have received has been checked and considered to have no lawful or legal standing, you are well within your rights to return the mail and include a 'Neutral Response'.

Returning the Original:

Return the original documents and even the envelope back to them, after you have made copies. This means that it is not retained or no contract to retain. Retain means "to keep in possession" and could be, although unlawfully, taken as acceptance of a contract.

Name and Address:

When returning mail, with a *Notice of Neutral Response* or *Notice of Unable to Respond* only put information in your notice that was originally highlighted in the mail you received.

For example: If your name was **not** in the original mail sent to you, then you should **not** include your name in your returning notice.

Your name or signature and possibly your address should not appear on anything you send back.

Certified Mail:

Send it back with certified mail. Do not use your address in the return address; use the same address as its being sent to.

This is to stop them refusing the mail, as it would just keep being sent back to them.

Witness:

When returning this mail you can get two witnesses to accompany you to the post office and even record the event of returning the documents.

You can also add this fact to the return notice if you wish.

Fee Schedule:

You can add your costs to process this if they should try again.

Legal Fiction:

Almost every time you receive fraudulent mail, there may not be a name attached, only the name of a corporation or agency, which would be a legal fiction.

It is always prudent to send a notice to a real person by name, rather than a corporation.

So if possible, always return to a real person by name and not a legal fiction.
